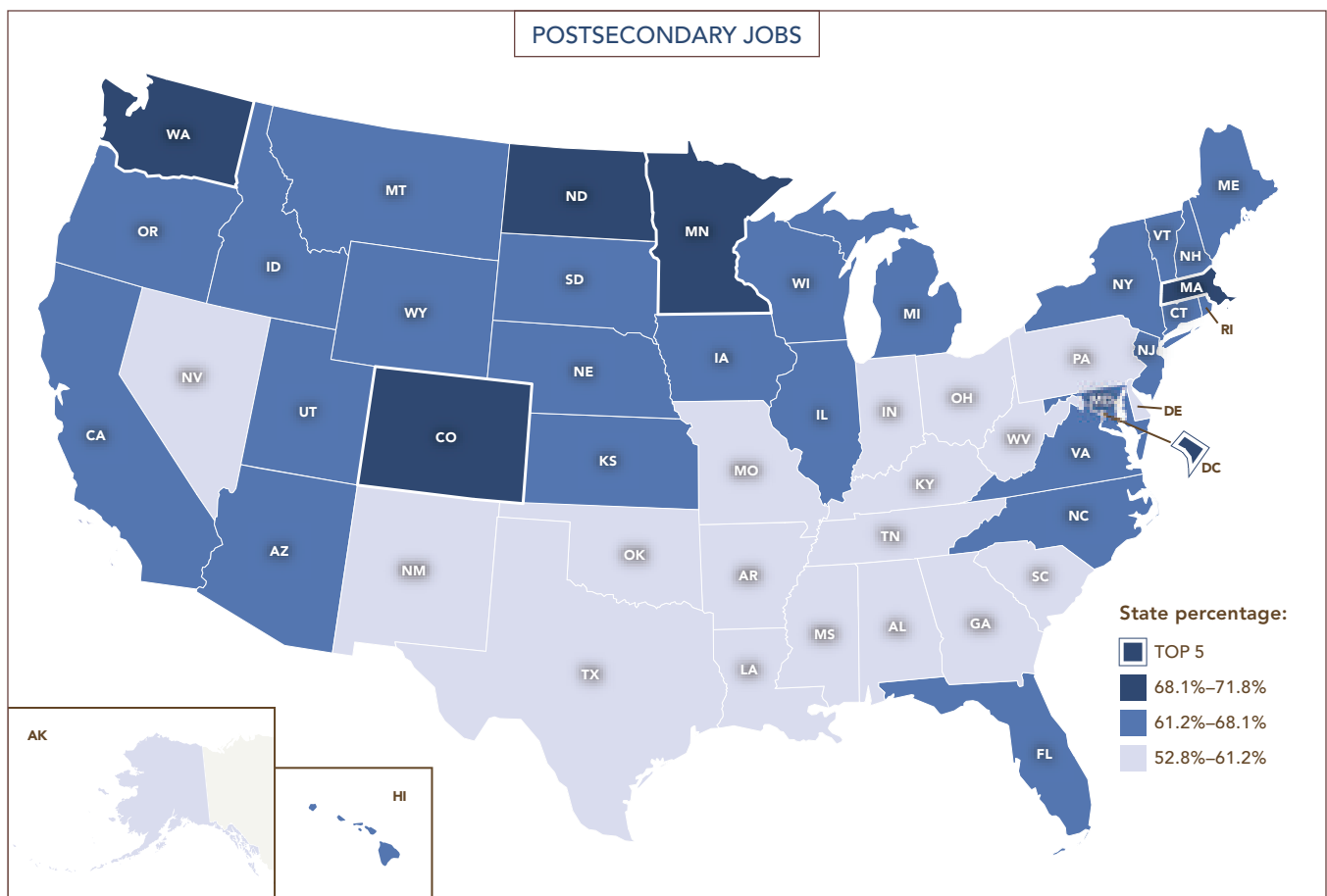


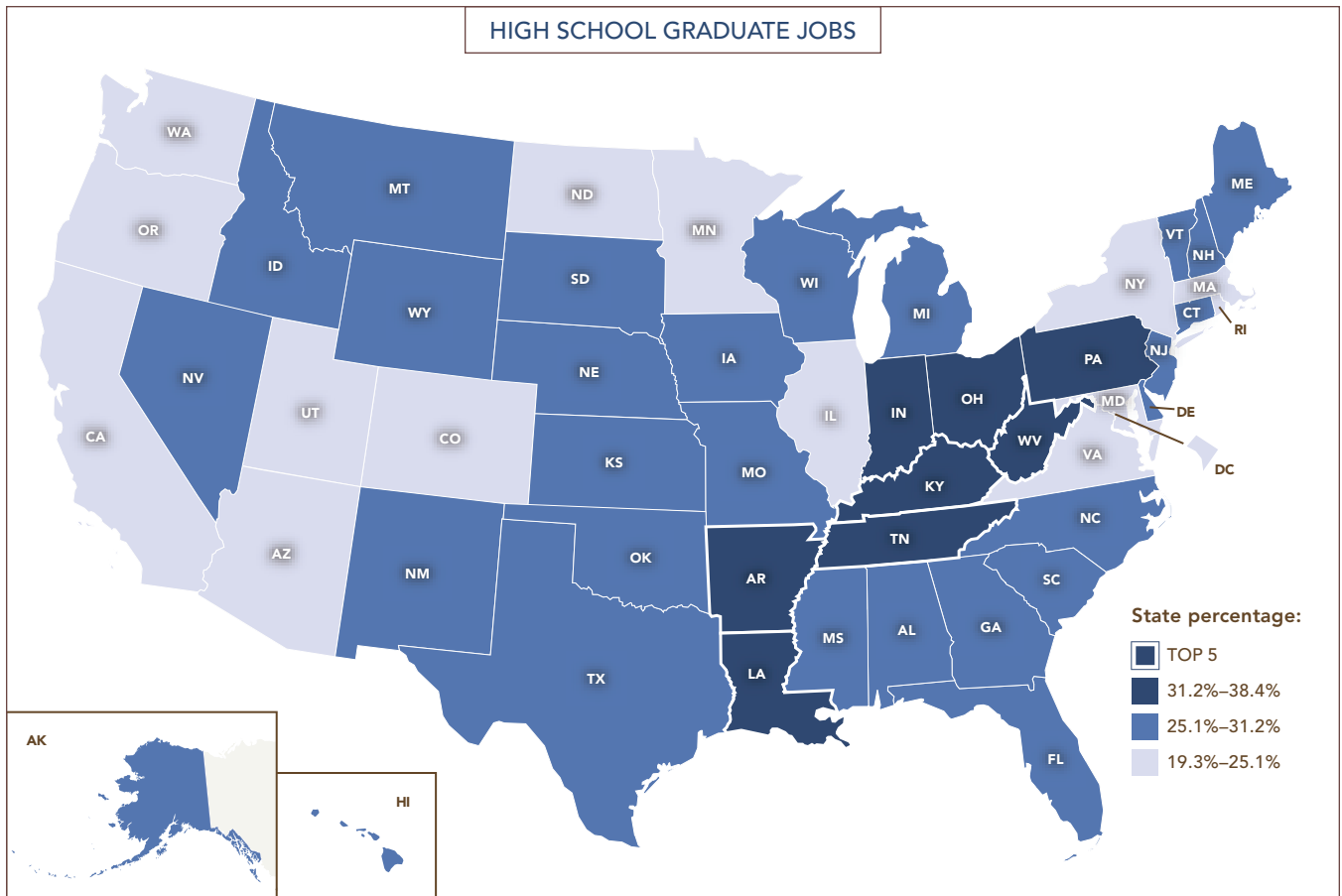

U.S. Maps: Educational concentrations of job openings by state though 2018.

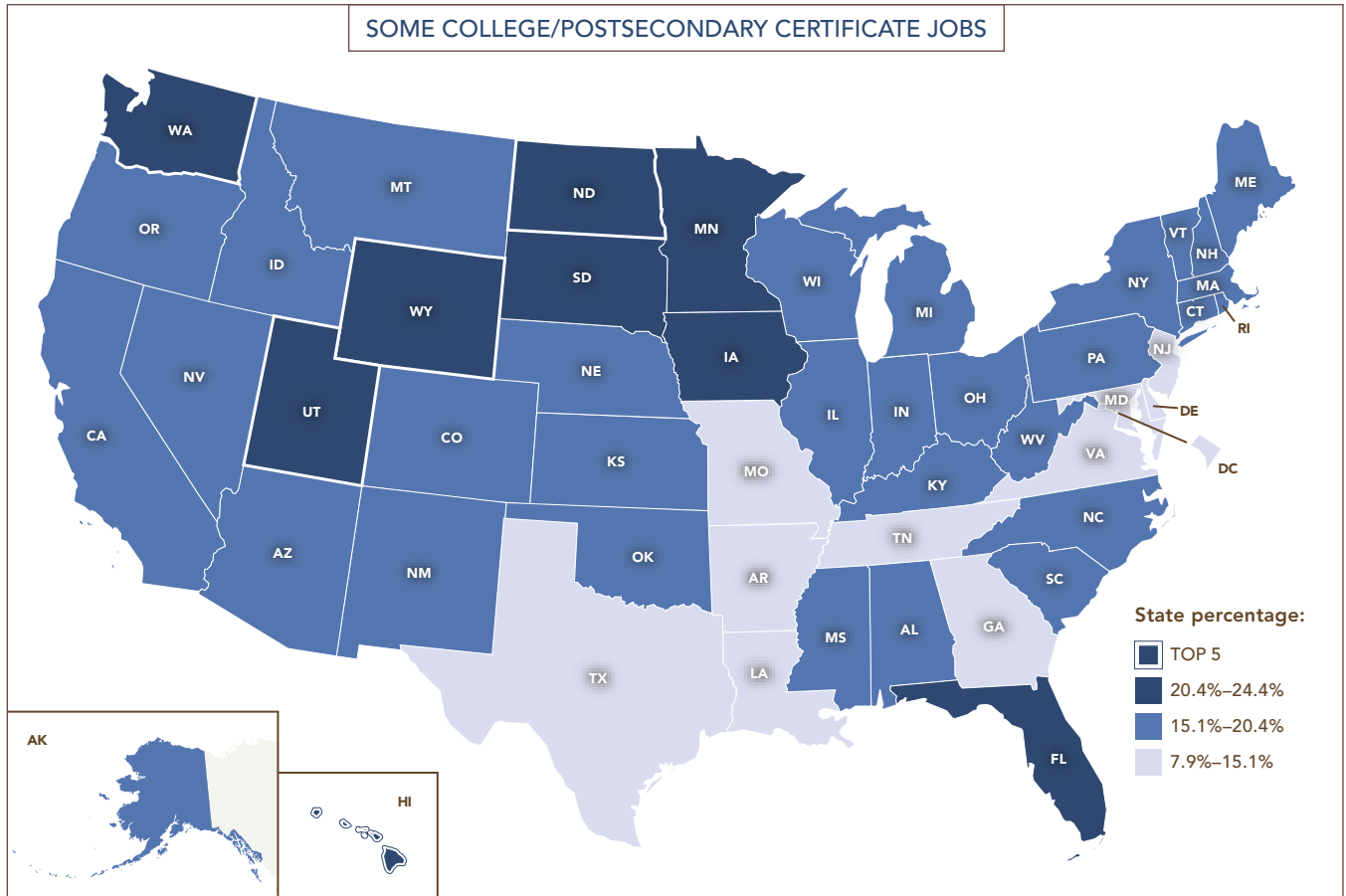

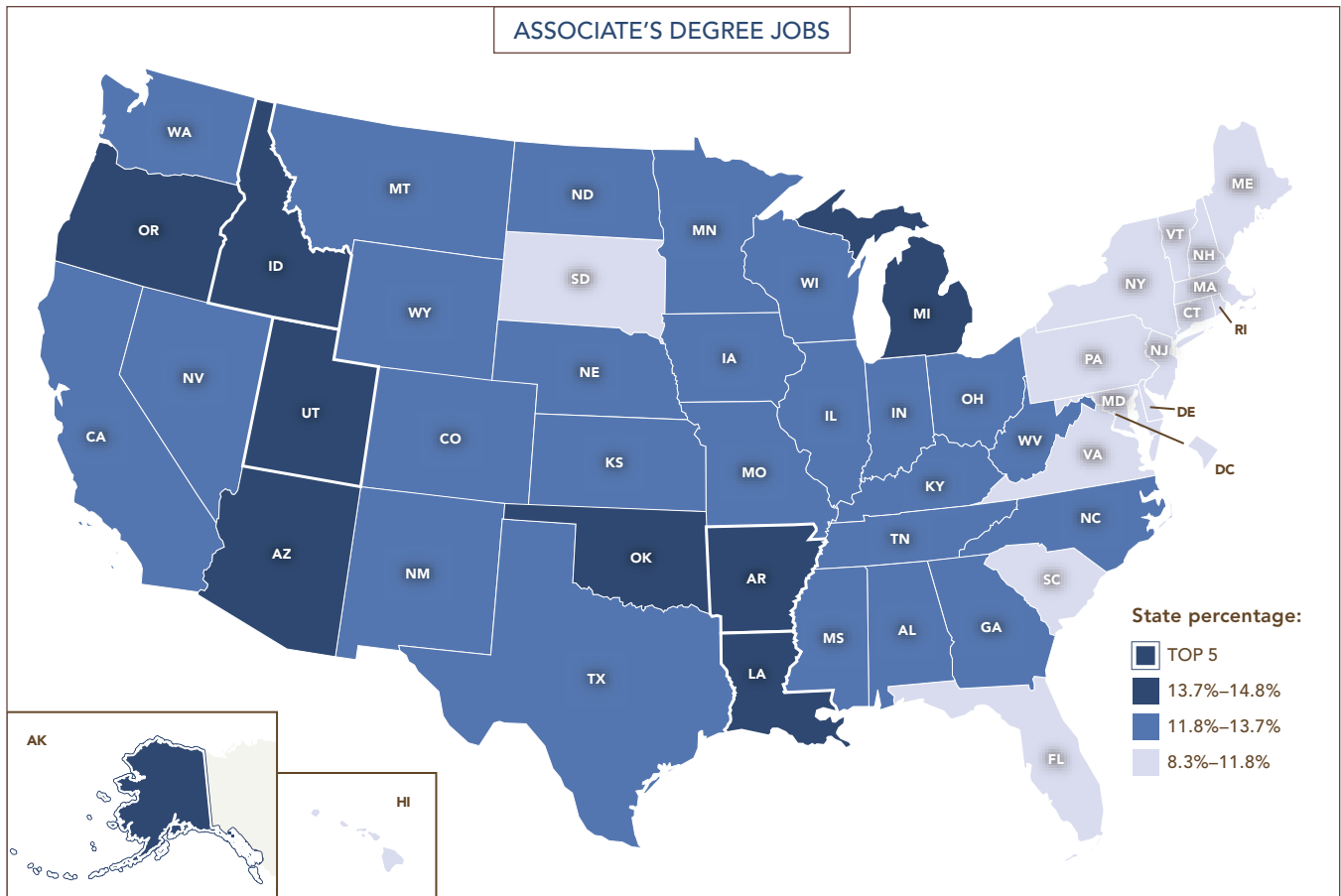
